The Ghana Energy Awards (GEA) announces the postponement of the Media Launch and Opening of Nominations for the 9th Ghana Energy Awards, originally scheduled for Tuesday, 12th August 2025. This difficult decision follows extensive consultations with our stakeholders and partners.

Ghana stands united in grief following the tragic loss of distinguished statesmen and gallant soldiers in the recent horrific helicopter crash. Our deepest condolences go out to the families, loved ones, and colleagues of these national heroes. We share in the profound sorrow felt across the nation.

In the spirit of national unity and out of deep respect for the precious lives lost, we believe it is essential to stand together as a country to honour their memory. The Ghana Energy Awards fully supports the Government's declaration of a three-day National Mourning period, the opening of Books of Condolence, and the preparations for the inter-denominational state funeral for the eight heroes at the Black Star Square on Friday, 15th August 2025.
